



Questions on the educational setting status form for schools

These are the questions which will appear on the collection form for school settings. They have been reproduced here so you can see the information you'll need to provide.

Question: What is the current status of your educational setting?

Answers you can select from:

- Open
- Closed due to coronavirus (COVID-19) related reasons
- Closed due to non-coronavirus (COVID-19) related reasons
- Teacher training or inset day

Open

Question: What additional measures has your setting implemented today?

Question: Of those pupils or students on roll, how many have a social worker?

Answer guide: Provide the total number of students on roll who are assessed as being in need under section 17 of the Children Act 1989, including children and young people who have a child in need plan, a child protection plan or who are a looked-after child. Also, provide the total number of these pupils or students irrespective of whether or not those pupils or students have an education, health and care (EHC) plan.

Question: Of those pupils or students on roll, how many are eligible for Free School Meals?

Answer guide: Do not include pupils eligible for universal infant free school meals.

Question: How many pupils or students are attending your setting today?

Answer guide: Enter the relevant figure.

Question: Of those pupils or students, how many have an education, health and care (EHC) plan?

Answer guide: Provide the total number of students attending your setting today with an education, health and care (EHC) plan irrespective of whether or not those pupils or students have a social worker.

Question: Of those pupils or students, how many have a social worker?

Answer guide: Include all pupils or students who are assessed as being in need under section 17 of the Children Act 1989, including children and young people who have a child in need plan, a child protection plan or who are a looked-after child. Question: Of those pupils or students attending your setting today, how many are eligible for free school meals?

Answer guide: Do not include pupils or students eligible for universal infant free school meals.

Question: Is your setting undertaking a phased return to enable the delivery of on-site asymptomatic testing to pupils or students?

Answer guide: Yes or No.

If Yes:

Question: How many pupils or students are not on site today because they are part of the phased return process?

Answer guide: Enter the relevant figure.

Question: How many pupils or students are unable to attend on site due to coronavirus (COVID-19) related reasons?

Hint text: Do not count a pupil or student more than once. Individuals should be recorded in one category only.

Select from the following answers:

- Suspected case of coronavirus (COVID-19)
- Confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19)

Hint text: Include all those with a positive result during asymptomatic testing

- Required to remain at home or isolate by NHS Test and Trace because they are over the age of 18 years and 6 months and not fully vaccinated
- Absent due to attendance restrictions put in place to manage an outbreak within your setting
- Absent due to isolation for other reasons

Question: Is your setting able to provide minimum hours of remote learning to the pupils or students not on site today?

Question: Do you have arrangements in place to provide free school meals for pupils or students who are not on site today?

Question: What free school meals arrangements do you have in place for pupils or students who are self-isolating due to coronavirus (COVID-19) related reasons?

Answer guide: Select all that apply:

- Food parcels
- Locally arranged vouchers
- Other – free text box (1000 characters)

Question: Does your setting offer any on-site breakfast clubs, after-school clubs or other childcare provision, either run by your own staff or an external provider?

Answer guide: Select one from the following:

- Yes, breakfast and after-school clubs
- Yes, other childcare provision

Question: Has your setting had to cancel any breakfast clubs, after-school clubs, or

other childcare provision today due to coronavirus (COVID-19) related reasons?

- Yes, we have had to cancel up to half of the clubs or other childcare provision
- Yes, we have had to cancel more than half of the clubs or other childcare provision

Question: How many teachers, including school leaders, are on roll at your setting?

Answer guide: Enter the relevant figure. Do not include any supply or agency staff in this figure.

Question: How many teaching assistants and other staff are on roll at your setting?

Answer guide: Enter the relevant figure.

Question: How many of your teachers, including school leaders are unavailable to teach on site for following reasons?

Answer guide: Do not count a teacher or school leader more than once. Individuals should be recorded in one category only.

Select from the following answers:

- Suspected case of coronavirus (COVID-19)
- Confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19)
Hint text - Include all those with a positive result during asymptomatic testing
- Required to remain at home or isolate by NHS Test and Trace due to close contact with a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19) within your setting
- Required to remain at home or isolate by NHS Test and Trace due to close contact with a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19) outside your setting
- Other reasons for absence

Question: How many of your teaching assistants and other staff are unable to attend the setting today for following reasons?

Answer guide: Do not count a teaching assistant or other staff member more than once. Individuals should be recorded in one category only.

Hint text - Include all those with a positive result during asymptomatic testing
